Supplementary Regulations



- THE EVENT** A multi-club motorkhana held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the National Motorkhana Code (NMC) and current Group 5 Motorkhana Guidelines, and these Supplementary Regulations and any further Regulations that may be issued. CAMS Permit No. 311/2205/06. The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au
- The event will comprise a round of the 2011 NGK Junior Pentathlon Series
- Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.
- DATE** Sunday, May 22, 2011.

- SURFACE** Grass and/or hard dirt - **note tyre restrictions.**

- ENTRIES** The entry fee will be **\$15.00 per driver**, or **\$8.00 for drivers 12 under 18 years of age on Feb 6**. Personal accident insurance is provided. Entries must be made on the official entry form and forwarded to Secretary. Entries open on publication of these regulations, **and close at 10.00 am on May 22**. Current CAMS Licence, Club Membership Card, and CAMS Log Book and Competition Record (if issued) must be presented prior to competing. Cheques and money orders should be made payable to Huntingdale Auto Club Inc. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry in accordance with NCR 83. The maximum number of entries accepted will be 60.
- LIMITATIONS** The organisers reserve the right to alter, abandon, postpone or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59.
- DRIVERS** All drivers must hold at least a CAMS Level 2NS Licence, and be a current financial member of a CAMS Victorian affiliated club. Drivers of cars to which no windscreen is fitted must wear adequate eye protection whilst competing. Adequate footwear must be worn by all drivers whilst competing - bare feet, thongs or sandals will not be permitted (all driver apparel shall comply with Schedule D). **A helmet complying with Schedule D of the 2011 CAMS Manual must be worn by all drivers competing in Class E.**
- VEHICLES** Vehicles must comply with General Requirements for Cars and Drivers, Schedule A of the NCR's, and also the rules for Group 4H Motorkhana cars. Non-production vehicles and Moke-type vehicles must be fitted with seat belt and roll bar complying with CAMS regulations. Mufflers must be fitted to all cars. Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G of the 2011 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- TYRES** ***Wintertread, rally type, bar- or lug-type or hand-cut tyres are not permitted.***
- SCRUTINY** All cars will be subject to a scrutiny inspection at or near the start garage prior to the start of the first test. A drivers' briefing will be held at approximately 10.15 am.
- TESTS** The tests will commence at 10.30 am. A minimum of four and a maximum of ten tests will be conducted. Test dimensions may be varied from the specified minimum dimensions as shown in the NMC or the Victorian Appendix.

- TIMING** Timing will be by hand-held stopwatches. Timekeepers and observers will be Judges of Fact as specified in the NMC clauses 17.2 & 17.3.
- PENALTIES** As per the NMC and the current Group 5 Motorkhana Guidelines (note that any reference to slowest time or fastest time shall only apply to that class).
- PROTESTS** Protests, if any, must be made in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.
- EXCLUSIONS** A driver may be excluded from the event at the Director's discretion for dangerous driving either on or off the test area. Any competitor taking or under the influence of alcohol or drugs during the event will be excluded, and may be the subject of further action by the Stewards.
- CLASSES**
- A vehicles up to 4250mm in length, with engine over the drive wheels
 - B vehicles up to 4250mm in length, with engine not over the drive wheels
 - C vehicles over 4250mm in length, with engine over the drive wheels
 - D vehicles over 4250mm in length, with engine not over the drive wheels
 - E Specials -
 - (a) unregistrable or non-production vehicles, or
 - (b) significantly lightened vehicles, or
 - (c) vehicles fitted with fiddle brakes or with a foot brake operating on the rear wheels only.
- AWARDS** Certificates will be awarded to the winner of each class, including junior, providing that class has at least three entries.

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

NOTE **Food will be available at the event.**

The event will be cancelled if excessive rain occurs. If in doubt contact David Isherwood (0418 440 758) until 2200 hrs on Saturday or on Sunday morning.

CLUB CARS:

Club cars are available to junior competitors only who are members of PAC or HAC, at a fee of \$10-00 per day. Juniors wishing to use a club car must book same, by phoning the event director by Friday 20th May 2011. There are a limited number of club cars available to competitors. It is advisable to book early as Club cars will be allocated to competitors in order of receipt of applications.
