THE EVENT

A multi-club motorkhana held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR's) of Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the National Motorkhana Code (NMC), the CAMS Guidelines for Passengers in Vehicles, Group5 Motorkhana Series Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations that may be issued. CAMS Permit number **311/0307/05**

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

In addition to the "main" event, a non competitive practice in the early afternoon will be held where selected drivers will be invited to take scouts for a passenger ride to promote motorsport to new members. See Appendix A for further details.

ENTRIES

Entries should be sent c/o Entries Secretary - PO Box 631 Lilydale 3140 Tel 0416 001577 (Frank). The entry fee will be \$15 per driver or \$10 per driver under 18 years of age. Personal accident insurance is included. Entries must be made on the official entry form. Entries open on printing of these regulations and close at the start of competition on Sunday 3rd July 2011. Cheques and Money Orders should be made payable to the Holden Sporting Car Club of Victoria. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry in accordance with NCR 83. A maximum of 80 entries will be allowed, accepted in order of receipt of payment and completed forms.

DRIVERS

All drivers must hold at least a CAMS Level 2NS Licence (which *may* be available for purchase on the day, but drivers should try to acquire a license from their club beforehand) and be a current member of a CAMS affiliated club. Drivers in vehicles with no windscreen must wear adequate eye protection in accordance with Schedule D of the 2011 CAMS Manual when competing. Adequate footwear must be worn by all drivers whilst competing (i.e. no bare feet or thongs).

PASSENGERS	A single passenger may be carried by competitors during the event. During competition, all passengers must be older than 12 years of age and either be another competitor, or have signed the passenger indemnity form. All aspects regarding passengers must comply with the National Motorkhana Code (article 19) and the CAMS Guidelines for Passengers in Vehicles.
LIMITATIONS	The organisers reserve the right to alter, postpone, or abandon the event in accordance with NCR 59 or if weather conditions warrant.
VEHICLES	Vehicles must comply with Schedule A of the 2011 CAMS Manual and the rules for Group 4H Motorkhana cars. Non production and Moke type vehicles must be fitted with an approved seat belt and roll bar. Appropriate mufflers must be fitted to all vehicles. The Clerk of Course will have the final say on the noise acceptability on the day. Vehicle logbooks must be presented if issued. Scrutiny shall commence at 8:30am.
FUEL	Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the 2011 CAMS Manual.
TYRES	Wintertread, 4WD, bar or lug type, and hand cut tyres will not be permitted. The Clerk of the Course will have the final say on the tyres eligibility on the day.
TESTS	Tests will commence at 10am sharp, preceded by the compulsory driver's briefing at 9:50am. A minimum of 4 and a maximum of 16 tests will be conducted. Test dimensions may be varied from the specified minimum dimensions as shown.
TIMING	Timing will be by hand held stop watches or via electronic timing equipment. Timekeepers will be judges of fact as specified in the NMC clauses 17.2 & 17.3
PENALTIES	As per NMC and Group5 Motorkhana Series Regulations, with reference to the slowest time or fastest time only applying to that class.
PROTESTS	Protests if any must be made in accordance with part XII of the NCR's.
EXCLUSIONS	<p>During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).</p> <p>The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.</p>
CLASSES	<p><u>As per the adopted 2011 Group5 class rules.</u></p> <p>A - Vehicles up to 4.25m in length, engine over drive. B - Vehicles up to 4.25m in length, engine away from drive C - Vehicles over 4.25m in length, engine over drive. D - Vehicles over 4.25m in length, engine away from drive E – Specials - significantly lightened vehicles - vehicles fitted with fiddle brakes or with a foot brake operating the rear wheels only. J – Juniors under 18years of age with handicap factors applicable to car class. Note - Rally tires are not permitted</p>
AWARDS	Trophies will be presented to the winner of each class provided that the class has at least 3 entries for the event.
INSURANCE	Insurance is provided in accordance with Appendix I of the 2011 CAMS Manual.
