THE MEETING:

The meeting shall be a **State Championship Motorkhana** conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR's) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the National Motorkhana Code, the 2011 VMC Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations issued by the promoter. The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au

Up to 5 drivers (and any number of Juniors) may compete in any one car, provided that this is indicated on the entry form. A maximum of 60 entries will be accepted, in order of receipt. The promoter reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NC R 83 and to cancel the meeting if, in its opinion, insufficient entries are received in accordance with NCR 59. Insurance will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the CAMS Manual.

Scrutiny: 8.30 to 10.00 am
Compulsory drivers briefing: 10:15 am
Competition starts: 10:30 am
Event finishes: approx. 4.00 pm

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS:

All drivers are required to be a member of a Victorian CAMS Affiliated Car Club, hold a minimum of a CAMS Level 2NS Licence and must wear adequate (fully enclosed) footwear whilst competing. Drivers of cars to which no windscreen is fitted must wear adequate eye protection. Drivers of vehicles classified as specials must wear a helmet which complies with AS 1698 and carries markings to that effect or otherwise be of a standard listed in the current CAMS Manual and appropriately marked to that effect and be deemed by the scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for motor sport use. All competitors shall comply with the apparel requirements in Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual.

Passengers are not permitted save that Juniors who have not competed in at least 3 previous events must be accompanied by an adult supervisor. Passengers must complete the relevant disclaimer before participating in the event.

SCRUTINY:

All vehicles shall comply with the provisions of the National Motorkhana Code and of Group 4H. For any VMC round conducted on an unsealed surface, Winter tread, Hand-cut, Bar-tread or Rally tyres are not permitted. Production cars may be modified, but weight, silhouette and any modifications must be in accordance with those specified in the Group 4H Section 2. Vehicles must comply with the CAMS NCR Section 13, Group 4H "Motorkhana Cars". Current club membership card, CAMS licence and CAMS vehicle logbook (if issued) must be presented. All vehicles must comply to a maximum noise limit of 94dBa as determined by the scrutineer. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual.

ROPS

All specials, Mini Mokes and similar vehicles including such as open or soft-topped 4WDs must have Roll over protection in accordance with Group 4H of the CAMS Manual.

THE EVENT:

The surface will be dirt/grass. The event will consist of a minimum of four tests selected from the National Motorkhana Code Test Book. Test dimensions may be varied from the specified minima. Timing will be by two hand held stop watches, one (the master watch) to record the official time, and one as a back up time should the official fail. Officials appointed to each test are Judges of Fact with respect to penalties as prescribed in the NMC.

CLASSES:

Class A: Production Cars: up to 2450 mm wheelbase; 2WD EOD#, ME# or 4WD.

Class B: Production Cars: up to 2450 mm wheelbase; 2WD EAD#.

Class C: Production Cars: 2451 - 2660 mm wheelbase; 2WD-EOD#, ME# or 4WD

Class D: Production Cars: 2451 - 2660 mm wheelbase; 2WD EAD#

Class E: Production Cars: 2661 mm and Over wheelbase; 2WD or 4WD

Class F: Front wheel drive Specials

Class R: Rear wheel drive Specials

Class L: Ladies [note iii]

Class J: Juniors [notes i & iii]

Class N: Novices [notes ii & iii]

Class M: Masters [notes iii & v]

EAD = Engine away from Drive; EOD = Engine over Drive; ME = Mid-Engined

Notes: i. Juniors in the Victorian Motorkhana Championship are defined as being under 18 years of age on the day of the first scheduled VMC round in the year of competition, and having attained the age of 12 years.

ii. Novices are defined as competitors who have not scored 4 or more class or outright points in any previous year of VMC competition.

iii. For classes L, J, N and M a handicap system shall operate based on the class of the competing vehicle. Results within the class shall be determined by multiplying each competitor's aggregate time, including any penalties, by the following factors: Class A 0.90, B 0.88, C 0.88, D 0.84, E 0.80, F 1.00, R 1.00 for the class of vehicle which was used.

iv. Drivers are eligible to compete and to gain points in only one class at each round. The chosen class must be nominated on the entry form.

v. Masters must have attained 60 years on the day of the first scheduled VMC Round in the year of competition.

vi. A driver may be reclassified for round awards at the discretion of the Clerk of Course if the driver's nominated class has less than 3 entries. This shall not change that driver's class for annual awards points.

10 CLUB CARS:

Club cars are available to junior competitors only, at a fee of \$10-00 per day. Juniors wishing to use a club car must book same, by phoning the event secretary prior to the close of early entries. There are a limited number of club cars available to competitors. It is advisable to book early as Club cars will be allocated to competitors in order of receipt of applications.

11 PENALTIES:

(a) Test penalties shall be imposed as per the Motorkhana Code,

(b) Excessive speed +/- or dangerous activity in the pits, any abusive behaviour: Exclusion from the meeting.

12 PROTESTS:

Must be made in accordance with NCR Part XII.

13 ANTI DOPING POLICY:

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS

Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.

FACILITIES/ CATERING:

Toilets are available at the venue. Food and beverages will available at the venue

FORCE MAJEURE:

The organisers reserve the right to postpone or abandon the event in accordance with NCR 59.

The event may be postponed if there is heavy rain in the area.

MCGREGOR ROAD

Drivers are asked to drive in a responsible manner and keep their speed below 60km/h along McGregor road to minimize any dust nuisance to residents.
